Visitor Parking Areas: What you need to know

When parking at the Student Health Center (Lot 19A), Gottschalk Medical Plaza (Lot 80), and the University Club (Lot 18B), you will see sequentially numbered parking stalls. When visiting these locations, please follow these simple guidelines.

After parking in a numbered stall:

1. Proceed into the building and give the stall number to the receptionist. If the front desk is not staffed, enter your name, parking space number and vehicle information (car make, model and color) on the visitor sign-in sheet.

2. Follow the posted time limits. If you are unsure of the time limit for your stall, check with the receptionist inside the building.

The information you provide to the receptionist will be logged into a computer system that is checked by UCI Enforcement Officers prior to citation issuance. As long as you park in the designated stalls, provide your vehicle information and follow the posted time limits, you will not receive a citation.
