Transportation and Distribution Services offers several services that address the rare travel issues encountered by UC Irvine commuters:

Did you forget your parking permit? Stop by one of the parking kiosks, give your name to the attendant and you will be issued a temporary permit for your use that day.

Need to run errands during lunch time, but worried about finding a parking spot when you return? Just stop by a parking kiosk between noon and 1:30 p.m. and ask the attendant for a Lunchtime Upgrade reserved permit. You will receive a temporary parking permit that allows you to park in a reserved stall (Please Note: the Lunchtime Upgrade permit is not valid in lots 7, 8, 12B or 80).

Are you traveling to a conference or need to leave your car on campus overnight? Simply fill out the Overnight Vehicle Request Form located on the T&DS website at: <https://www.parking.uci.edu/forms/overnightparking/overnightRequest.cfm>. The form should be submitted at least 24 hours prior to the requested time frame.
