

**COMMUNITY COLLABORATION** 

#### <u>Pedestrian-only turnstiles</u> were recently installed to improve safety along the Aldrich Hall service road sidewalk. As a reminder, all micromobility devices must be walked in pedestrian-only areas, including this designated dismount zone. While micromobility device use is encouraged as a means of transportation to the campus, all e-scooters, skateboards, and similar devices must be dismounted once inside the campus core. Cyclists must follow posted safety regulations and may ride only on designated bike paths **Expanded ARC Bike Resources Available** Ride to the Anteater Recreation Center (ARC) this summer and take advantage of the newly installed bike racks offering nearly 100 additional spaces.
